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hidden in the heart of the old city of barcelona is the cemetery of lost books a labyrinthine library of obscure and forgotten titles that have long gone out of print to this library a man brings his 10 year old son daniel one cold morning in 1945 daniel is allowed to choose one book from the shelves and pulls out la sombra del viento by julian carax but as he grows up several people seem inordinately interested in his find then one night as he is wandering the old streets once more daniel is approached by a figure who reminds him of a character from la sombra del viento a character who turns out to be the devil this man is tracking down every last copy of carax s work in order to burn them what begins as a case of literary curiosity turns into a race to find out

the poems speak frankly about death but they also exhibit a remarkable subtle understanding of life that comes only from those who are threatened so tangibly with its loss

el cementerio de los libros olvidados el cuarteto de novelas que arranca con la sombra del viento y sigue con el juego del Ángel se ha convertido en la gran saga novelística en curso de nuestro tiempo la leyenda comenzaba en el año 2000 cuando ruiz zafón culminaba su primera novela para adultos y estaba a punto de dar a conocer un libro mágico que cambiaría el panorama literario y que hoy sigue ganando el corazón de miles de lectores en todo el mundo un amanecer de 1945 un muchacho es conducido por su padre a un misterioso lugar oculto en el corazón de la ciudad vieja el cementerio de los libros olvidados allí daniel sempere encuentra un libro maldito que cambia el rumbo de su vida y le arrastra a un laberinto de intrigas y secretos enterrados en el alma oscura de la ciudad la sombra del viento es un misterio literario ambientado en la barcelona de la primera mitad del siglo xx desde los últimos esplendores del modernismo hasta las tinieblas de la posguerra aunando las técnicas del relato de intriga y suspense la novela histórica y la comedia de costumbres la sombra del viento es sobre todo una trágica historia de amor cuyo eco se proyecta a través del tiempo con gran fuerza narrativa el autor entrelaza tramas y enigmas a modo de muñecas rusas en un inolvidable relato sobre los secretos del corazón y el embrujo de los libros cuya intriga se mantiene hasta la última página

un gran enigma a calcuta calcuta 1932 el cor de les tenebres un tren en flames travessa la ciutat un espectre de foc sembla el terror en les ombres de la nit però això només és el principi el dia abans de complir setze anys ben sheere i els seus amics hauran d'enfrontar-se al més terrible i mortífer enigma de la història de la ciutat dels palaus la gent que habita els seus carrers sap que la veritable història va ser escrita en les pàgines invisibles dels seus esperits en les seves malediccions ocultes

escriu aquestes paraules amb l'esperança i el convenciment que algun dia descobriràs aquest lloc un lloc que va canviar la meua vida com estic segur que canviarà la teua barcelona 1957 daniel sempre i el seu amic fermín els herois de l'ombra del vent tornen de nou a l'aventura per afrontar el desafiament més gran de les seves vides just quan tot començava a somriure ls un inquietant personatge visita la llibreria de sempre i amenaça de desvelar un terrible secret que fa dècades que està enterrat en la fosca memòria de la ciutat en conèixer la veritat daniel comprendrà que el seu destí l'arrossega inexorablement a enfrontar-se a la més gran de les ombres la que està creixent en el seu interior plena d'intriga i emoció el presoner del cel és una novel·la magistral en què els fils de l'ombra del vent i el joc de l'Àngel convergeixen a través de l'encís de la literatura i ens condueixen cap a l'enigma que s'oculta en el cor del cementiri dels llibres oblidats
